



## **The Wound Healing Program**

Port Chester Nursing and Rehabilitation Centre is pleased to introduce The Wound Healing Program. We have responded to a community need for comprehensive wound care by establishing a formal program for long term care residents and short term residents post surgery/infection. Port Chester Nursing and Rehabilitation Centre is becoming known as the facility of choice for wound healing by many of the area's major hospitals.

With a history of successfully treating wounds, our commitment stems from a community need for quality treatment of wounds and an increase in admission of residents with various wound care needs. Our wound care team consists of our medical director, wound care nurses, infection control nurse, physical and occupational therapists and a dietitian. With strong community ties, our affiliated physicians in plastic surgery, general surgery, dermatology, podiatry, vascular and infectious disease provide consultation and service.

## **A Focus on Healing**

Upon admission for wound care, patients are evaluated by the wound care team to assess the wound for size, granulation, odor and drainage. The patient's overall health is considered when developing a plan of care. Our multi-disciplinary approach may include the use of IV antibiotics, specialized air mattresses, infection control techniques and

state-of-the-art equipment and devices, such as the negative pressure vacuum-assisted wound closure for reduced healing time and pain management. Pain management is a primary focus when treating wounds, with pain assessment done on daily rounds and analgesic patches applied prior to dressing changes, when appropriate, to optimize resident comfort.

## **A Skilled and Experienced Team**

Our history of excellent healing rates for Stage 1-4 wounds is the result of the dedication and expertise of our specialized program. In addition to a focus on wound healing, we treat the "whole" individual, offering physical and occupational therapy, recreation programs and activities and healthy, balanced meals served three times a day in our beautiful dining room. Because nutrition plays such a key role in the healing process, our registered dietitian provides

counseling and patient/family education on healthy and nutritious eating and also customizes a diet for each resident.
